Call for Participants: Peace Education in Scouting Training

What is the Peace Education Training?

We see peace education as an umbrella, consisting of 6 key areas: Diversity & Inclusion, Dialogue, Humanitarian Action, Safe from Harm, Advocacy, and Human Rights Education.

The Peace Education in Scouting training will support Member Organizations in the process of incorporating the above areas in their national Youth Programme and Adults in Scouting structures. Participants will gain new skills and approaches that would help enrich and reshape their Member Organisation (MO) practices regarding peace education.

What are the expected outcomes?

Being open to all, our Movement is one that strives for a culture of peace to permeate all our areas of work, and most importantly in the way we reach young people.

At the end of this training, participants will be able to:

- Apply the new learnings and competencies in their Scouting activities in relation to the six areas of Peace Education
- Recognise the six areas of Peace Education within their MO structures
- Identify opportunities for strengthening Peace Education within their MO
- Disseminate best practices and learning from the UAct project within their MO
- Understand their own role and potential as peace educators within Scouting
- Use this peer-to-peer learning and networking experience to strengthen partnerships and collaborations that promote a culture of peace

Who would benefit from this opportunity?

This call is for participants who are:

- Young people aged 18 - 30 years old, from a WOSM Member Organisation from the European Scout Region, and Moldova and Ukraine (UAct partner NSOs)
- Rovers, Scout leaders or Scout volunteers playing an active role at the national or local level within their MO
- Scouts holding a genuine interest in the six areas related to peace education: Diversity & Inclusion, Dialogue, Humanitarian Action, Safe from Harm, Advocacy, and Human Rights Education
- Scouts with availability and capacity to take back the learning outcomes to their MO within 2 months after the training is completed
